Your son/daughter will need to have the following for every Thursday between now and May 26, 2016:

- A bicycle in good working order. We will not include bike maintenance this year, so please bring a bike that is tuned up. Bikes must be for road travel—touring, mountain, hybrid or road bikes, no trick bikes please. Mr. Brown reserves the right to leave students behind without the right bike.
- An approved helmet with appropriate chin strap/clip.
- Appropriate clothing for cycling in Wednesday weather—RAIN OR SHINE!
- Art supplies—your own set of pencils, coloured pencils, coloured felt markers, etc. Students may bring their school pencil case or supplies of choice.

Students will be given "Sketch kits" including fine guality drawing paper. A fee of \$4 will be collected from each student for these kits. No students will denied participation in this activity for reasons of financial constraint. Please see Mr. Brown or our principal, Mr. Ken Andrews; any requests would be kept confidential. We conclude each afternoon dismissing from the Monterey schoolyard at, or about, 3:00pm. Here is where we **plan** to go for the next Wednesdays (subject to change based on the weather):

<u>Thurs April 7</u>: Meet and Greet in Mr. Brown's classroom, Rm. W202., introductions. Letter home. No biking this day. Walk and sketch near schoolgrounds.
<u>Thurs April 14</u>: Bike safety; training to ride in traffic. Windsor Park
<u>Thurs April 21</u>: Review riding skills. McNeill Bay (Kitty Islets)
<u>Thurs April 28</u>: Beach drawings: Oak Bay (Baynes Park, below Broom Rd & Beach Drive).
<u>Thurs. May 5</u>: Oak Bay Native Plant Garden, Beach Dr. & Margate Ave.
<u>Wed May 12</u>: : Trafalgar Lookout, Beach Drive.
<u>Wed. May 19</u>: refining our drawings; meet in Mr. Brown's classroom, Rm. W202. No biking this day.
