

Dear Parents of Division 4 (Mr. Robinson's) and Division 9 (Mr. Brown's):

Our classes are creating French dialogues using the vocabulary of "Les emotions". Our students will create sock puppets to act out their dialogues. To augment this, we have the wonderful opportunity to learn in our classroom from professional puppeteer, Mr. Tim Gosley on Wednesday March 25, 2015 and to visit the performance space/theatre, *Merlin's Sun*, a few blocks from our school on Tuesday April 7 PM (div. 9) or Wed. April 8 AM, 2015 (div. 4). Students will complete their French dialogues before Spring Break, and then on the week of March 23 construct sock puppets. All students need to bring one (1) pair of clean socks to school a.s.a.p. After Spring Break we will learn some puppetry techniques. On the following Tuesday afternoon Div. 9 students will walk to the 50 seat theatre at 1983 Fairfield Road, work with our puppets using camera, monitors and projection screens, and return to school by 3:00pm. Division 4 students will walk to the theatre on the Wednesday, departing at 10:15AM and returning by 1:00pm. Students must wear walking shoes and be prepared for the weather. The cost is \$9.00 (payment due by Fri. March 6, please). No student will be prevented from participating for reasons of financial constraint. Please see our principal Mr. Andrews for assistance (your privacy will be respected). However, students who neither pay nor make arrangements will remain at the school. Parent volunteers for the walk to/from *Merlin's Sun* are critical for the success of this field trip.
