## Final Review

Math - tests/quizzes/notebooks; please see the "Use your textbook for Math review" sheet.

Science - A handout will be provided showing the topics required for a final review.

French - A handout will be provided showing the vocabulary and topics required for a final review.

**Writing-** A written assignment using "powerful paragraphs" that contains advice for a student coming into Grade 6 from elementary school.
