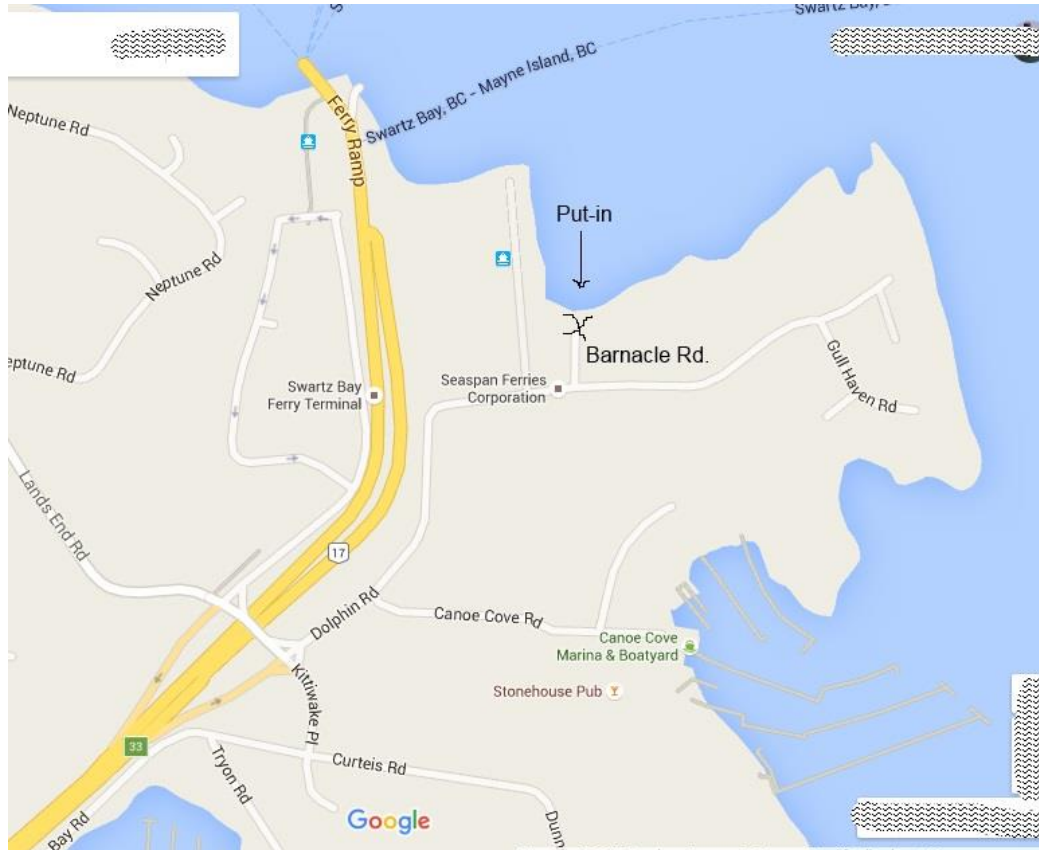


# Portland Island 2-Day expedition information

We are looking forward to our trip to Gulf Islands National Marine Park in less than 2 weeks!

Parents need to get their students with their camping gear to the Launch site (a.k.a. Put-in) at the Swartz Bay Public Wharf on Barnacle Road on the morning of their overnight trip.

"Dolphin Road" or "Barnacle Road" in Google Maps should help you find our launch site:



We encourage families to carpool with 2 or 3 students per vehicle.

**Green Group students need to be at the launch site at 8:00AM on Friday June 3. Green Group returns to the same place Saturday June 4 at 3:00pm. Students will be dismissed when the kayaks and gear are adequately put away.**

**Blue Group students need to be at the launch site at 8:00AM on Sunday June 5. Green Group returns to the same place Monday June 6 at 3:00pm. Students will be dismissed when the kayaks and gear are adequately put away.**

- Bring your water bottles filled with drinking water.
- Bring your Observation Book or some kind of journal.
- Bring a bandanna.
- Leave your devices at home (waterproof cameras welcome)
- Use the washroom before coming to the launch site as there are no facilities there.
