Thetis Lake directions

Green Group: Thursday October 16

Blue Group: Thursday Oct. 23



Please meet at Monterey School at ~7:50AM and be ready to drive students by 8:00AM. Proceed to Island Highway (TransCanada Hwy #1). [About 15 km]

Take the Colwood exit (Exit #10). At the second lights (about $\frac{1}{2}$ km) turn right at Six Mile Road (Six Mile Pub)

Proceed under the highway bridge and into Thetis Lake Park. Just past the large car parking lot (to left) **TURN LEFT** and drive slowly along a winding road to the "Canoe Beach" or "Dog walk Beach" (NOT the main beach, please). There is limited parking at Canoe Beach so please drop off students. If you wish to stay please use the big pay parking lot at the main entrance (about 10 minutes walk from Canoe Beach).

Students' kayak activities conclude at ~2:00pm but students must load the kayaks on the trailers under the guides' supervision before departing. Students return **IN THE SAME CARS**, directly to the school (regrets, no side trips please). If drivers are running late than a 3:00pm return to Monterey please advise the school at 250 598-4589.
